






Congratulations, 2024 Graduates!

The Lorain County Board of Developmental Disabilities convened at 6:30 p.m. on May 28, 2024

The Board passed a resolution authorizing for public release a draft of its 2023 Strategic Plan Progress Report, and gave notice of a public forum on this document to be held on June 12, 2024, at 1:45 p.m. at the Board's Administration Building, 1091 Infirmary Rd., Elyria, Ohio; a copy of the Draft 2023 Strategic Plan Progress Report can be accessed at www.murrayridgecenter.org or by calling (440)329-3734. The Board discussed site visits to its Adult Opportunity & Vocational Centers.
