




# WHAT'S NEW AT Murray Ridge School

### **Boardroom Briefing**

The Lorain County Board of Developmental Disabilities convened at 6:30 p.m. on September 30, 2024

Board member Rebecca Cornman gave an update on the delivery of and selection of a nominee to receive a Quarterly Exceptional Service Award. In order to consolidate policy language pertinent to driving on Agency business, and to eliminate obsolete transportation-related policy provisions, the Board unanimously passed revisions to its policies on Ordering/Use of Supplies, Equipment and Vehicles, Investigation/Criminal Background Checks, and Verification of Driving Ability; and rescinded its policies on Locally-Funded Transportation and Non-Medical Transportation. The date/time of the next Organizational Meeting was set for January 27, 2025, at 6:30 pm. The Board appointed Board Member Ryan Egbertson as delegate and Superintendent Amber Fisher as alternate to the 2024 delegate assembly of the Ohio Association of County Boards Serving People with Developmental Disabilities. The Board visit to the Oberlin Opportunity and Vocational Center, to occur on October 22, 2024, was discussed.
