<u>School Aide</u>

Full Time, 9-month, and Intermittent (substitute) positions available.

- Support students with daily living skills.
- Assist teachers and carry out assigned activities in various settings.
- Help with busing and ride the bus with students when needed.
- Maintain records, share progress with teachers, and input data using basic computer programs.
- Provide/assist students with personal care.
- Collaborate as part of a transdisciplinary team and attend required meetings.



<u>Group Home Aide</u>

Full Time, Part Time, and Intermittent (substitute) positions available.

- Provide direct care in a residential setting, including personal care, transfers, and recreational activities.
- Implement Individual Service Plans (ISP/IHP).
- Maintain electronic records (progress notes, charts, reports).
- Transport residents to programs, appointments, and activities.
- Perform housekeeping tasks (bathrooms, laundry, kitchen, resident rooms, and activity clean-up).

All Candidates Must:


- Have valid Ohio drivers license, good driving record, and High School Diploma/GED
- Pass background check, drug test, and physical



Lifeguard

Full Time, 9-month position, following School calendar.

- Perform lifeguard responsibilities, including supervising students in the pool.
- Assist students with swim preparation, and post-swim needs.
- Document student performance relative to individual goals, as requested.
- Ensure pool area safety and cleanliness, and compliance with applicable rules and Public Health guidelines.
- Perform School Aide duties, as assigned (see position featured in the first column to the left); pool may be closed if a Lifeguard is needed to cover for classroom personnel.
- Work in lunch room, as needed.
- Attend meetings and events, as assigned.
